## NON- MOTORIZED TRAIL ACCESS



1-mile Walking Distance\* from an Access Point\*\* to a Non-motor Trail\*\*\*

20% of Berrien County Residence live within a \*walkable distance from a non-motor trail. The distance does not factor in roads that are not pedestrian friendly, such as roads having no sidewalks or shoulders.

\*\*Access points were approximated where the trail crosses roads which differs from a trailhead where parking is available.

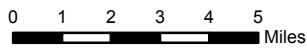
\*\*\*Non-motor Trails are defined as, greater than 6-ft wide, separated from the road, 1/2 mile long and linear in characteristics.
